ground junction box wire; it usually has green insulation around it or is bare wire. Fasten these together with a Wire Connector (A) and wrap the connection with electrical tape. Make sure no wire strands are exposed. If the ceiling outlet junction box does not have a ground junction box wire, insert the Ground Screw (E) into the Mounting Plate (C) where it's marked "Ground" facing downward, and wrap the fixture ground wire around the Ground Screw (E).

- 14. Tighten the Ground Screw (E) to clamp the Ground Fixture Wire between the head of the Ground Screw (E) and the Mounting Plate (C).
 It is imperative that the ceiling outlet junction box in your home be properly grounded!
- 15. Connect the neutral fixture wire to the neutral junction box wire; it usually has white insulation around it. Fasten these together with a Wire Connector (A) and wrap the connection with electrical tape. Make sure that no wire strands are exposed.
- 16. Connect the hot fixture wire to hot junction box wire; it usually has black insulation around it. Fasten them together with a Wire Connector (A) and wrap the connection with electrical tape. Make sure that no wire strands are exposed. Do not reverse the hot and neutral connections or safety will be compromised.

- **17.** Gently tuck the wire connections neatly into ceiling outlet junction box.
- 18. Place the Canopy (H) over the ceiling outlet junction box and secure it in place by screwing the Threaded Ring (J) onto the Screw Collar Loop (I).
- 19. Insert FIVE (5) 40-Watt maximum Type G standard medium base incandescent light bulbs (not included) or FIVE (5) 9-Watt compact fluorescent light bulbs (not included) or FIVE (5) 6-Watt LED light bulbs (no included) into the sockets. Do not exceed specified wattage. NOTE: We recommend using frosted or white round bulbs for this chandelier as clear bulbs will create shadowing on the glass shade. For your convenience, FIVE (5) 4-Watt frosted LED bulbs included with this chandelier.
- **20.** Put the Glass Shade (S) over the socket, Screw it in until tightened.
- **21.** Attach Curved Tube (R) to chandelier frame and secure it by Mini Screw (Q) using the Allen Wrench (P).
- **22.** Restore the power to junction box and test the fixture.
- 23. Installation is now completed.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Wipe clean with a soft, dry cloth or static duster.

Always avoid the use of harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners as they may cause damage to the chandelier's finish.


